

CLIMBERS CATALOGUE

A selection of climbers is available throughout the year. Some tender climbers may be moved in to our glasshouse area for winter protection.

ACTINIDIA *A deciduous, twining climber. Requires sun or partial shade in a fertile soil.*

A. deliciosa 'Hayward' Creamy-white to buff-yellow flowers in August are followed by large edible fruits. Hairy, heart-shaped, mid-green leaves. A MALE PLANT IS NEEDED TO POLLINATE THE FEMALE TO PRODUCE FRUIT. Height 7.5 metres.

A. deliciosa 'Tomurai' (Was A chinensis) MALE Creamy-white to buff-yellow flowers in August. Hairy, heart-shaped, mid-green leaves. A FEMALE PLANT IS NEEDED TO PRODUCE FRUITS.

A. kolomikta Grown for its leaves, the upper sections often creamy white and pink.. Has small, cup-shaped white flowers in June. Height 5.5 metres. Requires full sun and well-drained, moist, soil.

AKEBIA *A semi-evergreen twining climber. Requires moist soil in sun or part shade.*

A. quinata Vanilla-scented, red-purple flowers appear in April followed by sausage shaped, purplish fruits after a long hot summer. Leaves made up of five leaflets. Height to 4.5 m.

A. quinata Cream Form NEW & RARE. Vanilla-scented, cream flowers appear in April followed by sausage shaped, purplish fruits after a long hot summer. Leaves made up of five leaflets. Height to 4.5 m.

AMPELOPSIS *Deciduous, woody-stemmed tendril climber. For the best production of berries, plant in a sheltered site in full sun.*

A. brevipedunculata Small insignificant flowers followed by spectacular porcelain blue berries. Three to five lobed green leaves. Height up to 5.4 metres.

A. brevipedunculata 'Elegans' Grown for its attractive foliage, the green leaves are heavily mottled white and tinged pink. Height can reach 1.5 metres. An excellent container and patio plant.

A. megalophylla Small insignificant flowers followed by top shaped fruits. Large leaves, 30 to 60cm long, made up of two leaflets. Height grows slowly up to 9 metres.

ARISTOLOCHIA *Requires sun or part shade in a fertile soil. Can be grown through large shrubs.*

A. macrophylla Tubular flowers bent like a pipe at the end, yellowish-green, brownish purple at the mouth. June. Heart shaped leaves. Deciduous. Height to about 9 metres.

BERBERIDOPSIS *Twining climber. Requires partial shade and well-drained acid to neutral soil. Can be a difficult plant being susceptible to winter damage.*

B. corallina Pendent clusters of globular, dark red flowers are produced in August and September. Leathery, mid-green leaves with spiny edges, evergreen. Height to 4.5 metres.

BILLARDIA *An evergreen twining climber. Requires a sunny site in a moist, drained soil.*

B. longiflora Small bell shaped, sometimes purple-tinged, green-yellow flowers are produced singly in leaf axils in summer, followed by purple-blue fruits in autumn. Slender dark green leaves. Height 1.8 metres.

B. loniflora 'Cherry Brandy' Small bell shaped, sometimes purple-tinged, green-yellow flowers are produced singly in leaf axils in summer, followed by red fruits in autumn. Slender dark green leaves. Height 1.8 metres.

B. longiflora fructu-albo Small bell shaped, sometimes purple-tinged, green-yellow flowers are produced singly in leaf axils in summer, followed by white fruits in autumn. Slender dark green leaves. Height 1.8 metres

BOUGAINVILLEA Vigorous, mainly evergreen, woody stemmed, scrambling climber. Minimum temperature 7-10 degrees C. Requires full sun and well-drained soil. Prune after flowering. Excellent for a conservatory.

CAMPISIS Deciduous woody-stemmed climber. Prefers a sheltered position. Best in full sun to ripen the wood. Can be pruned in February or March.

C. grandiflora Trumpet shaped flowers of deep orange and red carried on the tips of the current years growth in August and September. Mid green leaves made up of many leaflets. Height up to 6 metres.

C. radicans Bears small red and gold flowers. Height to 10 metres. Requires fertile soil.

C. radicans Flamenco Bears small reddish pink flowers. Height to 10 metres. Requires fertile soil.

C. radicans f. flava Large, trumpet shaped, rich yellow flowers in August and September. Pale green leaves made up of up to eleven leaflets. Height to 5.5 metres. Requires fertile soil.

C. x tagliabuana Dancing Flame 'Huidan'

C. x tagliabuana ' Mme Galen' Large, trumpet shaped, salmon-red flowers are borne in pendent clusters in August and September. Mid green leaves made up of seven to eleven leaflets. Height to 5.5 m.

CELASTRUS Deciduous, twining climber. Requires sun or part shade in a moist, well-drained soil.

C. orbiculatus hermaphrodite Insignificant flowers may be followed by brown capsules which open to show a yellow lining and red seeds. Roundish pale green leaves, which turn brilliant yellow in autumn. Height up to 7.5 metres.

CLEMATIS Large range of spring, summer and autumn flowering climbers. Climbs by twining leaf stems around its support. Best in a rich soil with its head in the sun and the roots kept cool and moist in shade. **Different varieties have different pruning needs see each variety.**

C. alpina 'Columbine'

C. alpina ' Constance' Bell shaped, bright red flowers, a seedling of ' Ruby' flowering in April and May. Pale green finely divided leaves. Height 180 cm. Prune lightly, if required, after flowering.

C. alpina ' Francis Ravis' Large, deep blue, bell shaped flowers, April and May. Pale green leaflets. Height 1.8 metres. Prune lightly, if required, after flowering.

C. alpina ' Frankie' Blue, bell shaped flowers, April and May. Pale green leaflets. Height 2.5 metres. Prune lightly, if required, after flowering.

C. alpina ' Pamela Jackman' Bell shaped azure blue flowers, with creamy centres, April and May. Pale green leaflets. Height 1.8 metres. Prune lightly, if required, after flowering.

C. alpina ' Ruby' Bell shaped, rose red, flowers on long slender stalks appearing in April and May. Pale green finely divided leaves. Height 180cm. Prune lightly, if required, after flowering.

C. alp.var.sib. ' White Moth' Bell shaped, large white flower in April and May. Pale green leaflets. Height 1.8 metres. Prune lightly, if required, after flowering.

C. alpina ' Willy' Bell shaped, pink, flowers on long slender stalks appearing in April and May. Pale green finely divided leaves. Height 1.8 metres. Prune lightly after flowering to keep in allotted space.

C. 'Arctic Queen' Large, double, creamy-white flowers May to August. Green leaves. Height 1.8 to 2.4 metres. Best on South, West or East aspects. Prune lightly after the first flush.

C. armandii Scented, white, flowers, with a creamy centre, February to April. Long, leathery, green leaves, coppery when young, evergreen. Height a vigorous climber to 9 metres. Best on a warm, sunny, sheltered wall.

C. armandii ' Appleblossom' Scented, white, flowers, faintly shaded pink, February to April. Long, leathery, green leaves, coppery when young. Evergreen. Height a vigorous climber to 9 metres. Best on a warm, sunny, sheltered wall.

C. armandii ' Bowl of Beauty' Bowl shaped pure white very fragrant flowers, February to April. Scented. Coppery foliage when young, turning to mid green, evergreen. Height vigorous to 9 metres. Warm, sunny sheltered wall. Can be damaged in frosty weather. Prune after flowering if necessary.

C. armandii ' Snowdrift' Pure white with a creamy centre from February to April, scented. Coppery foliage when young, turning to mid green, evergreen. Height vigorous to 9 metres. Warm, sunny sheltered wall. Can be damaged in frosty weather. Prune after flowering if necessary.

- C. **'Asao'** Large, reddish-pink flowers with a white bar, May, June and September. Green leaves. Deciduous. Height 1.8 to 2.4 metres. Prune lightly in July.
- C. **'Ascotiensis'** Bright blue flowers with long pointed sepals and greenish stamens, July to September. Green leaves. Height 1.8 to 2.4 metres. Prune hard in Feb. or March.
- C. **'Barbara Jackman'** Soft petunia mauve with crimson bars and cream stamens, May, June and September. Green leaves. Deciduous. Height 1.8 to 2.4 metres. Prune lightly after the first flowers.
- C. **'Beauty of Worcester'** Double blue with a white centre, May and June, single flowers follow in September. Mid green leaves. Height 1.8 to 2.4 metres. Prune lightly in July.
- C. **'Bee' s Jubilee'** Mauve-pink flowers with darker bars, May, June and September. Green leaves. Height 1.8 to 2.4 metres. Prune lightly in July.
- C. **'Belle of Woking'** Double, pale mauve, May and June, single flowers often follow in September. Mid green leaves. Height 1.8 to 2.4 metres. Prune lightly in July.
- C. **'Bill McKenzie'** Yellowish, bell shaped, thick sepalled flowers in August and September. Finely cut leaves. Height up to 5 metres. Prune hard in Feb. or March.
- C. **'Blekitny Aniol'** Large white-blue flowers with ruffled sepals. June to August. Height 2 to 3 metres. Prune hard in Feb. or March.
- C. **'Blue Bird'** Bell shaped bluish-purple, semi-double, flowers in April and May. Pale green leaflets. Height 1.8 metres. Prune only to keep in allotted space.
- C. x **cartmanii 'Avalanche'** Masses of creamy-white flowers with yellow stamens, March to May. Deeply cut glossy green leaves, evergreen. Height 3 to 4 metres. Needs a sheltered site with protection from winter winds. Can be pruned after flowering if necessary.
- C. x **cartmanii 'Early Sensation'**
- C. x **cartmanii 'Joe'** Cream centred white flowers from March to May. Divided evergreen leaves. Height can be trained to about 2 metres but usually grown unsupported or through small shrubs. Requires full sun and a sheltered site.
- C. x **cartmanii 'Pixie'**

- C. **cirrrosa** A beautiful winter flowering climber with nodding, greenish, bells, spotted red on the inside. Flowers appear from December to February. Finely divided fresh green evergreen leaves. Height 3.5 metres. Requires full sun and a sheltered site.
- C. **cirrrosa var. pur. 'Freckles'** A beautiful winter flowering climber with nodding, greenish, bells, heavily spotted red inside. Flowers appear from December to February. Finely divided fresh green evergreen leaves. Height 3.5 metres.
- C. **cirrrosa var. balearica** A beautiful winter flowering climber with nodding, greenish, bells, spotted red on the inside. Flowers appear from December to February. Very finely divided fresh green, evergreen leaves. Height 3.5 metres. Requires full sun and a sheltered site.
- C. **cirrrosa 'Wisley Cream'** A beautiful winter flowering climber with nodding, creamy-white, bells appearing from December to February. Finely divided fresh green evergreen leaves. Height 3.5 metres. Requires full sun and a sheltered site.
- C. **'Comtesse de Bouchaud'** Mauve-pink flowers with cream stamens, free flowering. Green leaves. Height 1.8 to 2.4 metres. Prune hard in Feb. or March.
- C. **'Countess of Lovelace'** Bluish violet double flowers in early summer, followed by single flowers in late summer. Flowers appear from May to July. Mid green leaves. Ht: 1.8 to 2.4 m. Prune lightly in July.
- C. **'Daniel Deronda'** Single or semi-double bluish purple flowers with paler centre, June to September. Mid green leaves. Height 1.8 to 2.4 m. Prune lightly in July.
- C. **'Dawn'** Pale pink with darker tips and a purplish centre. Slightly scented, May and June. Green leaves. Height 1.8 to 2.1 metres. Prune lightly in July.
- C. **'Dr. Ruppel'** Rose pink with a carmine bar, golden stamens, late flowers vary in colour, May June and September. Green leaves. Height 1.8 to 2.4 metres. Prune lightly after
- C. **'Duchess of Edinburgh'** Double, rosette shaped, white flowers in May and June. Mid green leaves. Height 1.8 to 2.4 m. Prune lightly.
- C. x **durandii** Rich indigo blue flowers with a creamy yellow centre of stamens, June to September. Slender green leaves. Height 1.8 metres. Prune hard in Feb. or March.
- C. **'Elsa Spath'** Very large, lavender blue flowers in May and June then smaller flowers in September. Green leaves. Height 1.8 to 2.4 metres. Prune lightly after the first flowering.

- C. 'Ernest Markham'** Glowing, carmine red flowers, with a velvety sheen, June to September. Green leaves. Height 1.8 to 2.4 metres. Prune hard in February or March.
- C. flammula** Masses of small, white, scented flowers from August to October. Dark green, divided leaves. Deciduous. Height 3.5 metres. Prune hard in February.
- C. florida 'Alba Plena'** Double white, flowers, with a central boss, like a white passion flower, June and July. Dark green leaves. Deciduous to semi-evergreen. Height to 1.8 metres. Can be pruned in the spring. Sunny sheltered site.
- C. florida Pistachio**
- C. florida 'Sieboldii'** White with a central boss of rich purple, like a passion flower, June and July. Dark green leaves. Deciduous to semi-evergreen. Height to 1.8 metres. Can be pruned in the spring. Sunny sheltered site.
- C. 'General Sikorski'** Mid blue flowers, sometimes reddish at the base, May, June and again in September. Green leaves. Height 1.8 to 2.4 metres. Prune lightly after the first flowers.
- C. 'Gillian Blades'** White flowers in May and June and again in August. Mid green leaves. Height 1.8 to 2.4 m.. Prune lightly in July if required.
- C. 'Gipsy Queen'** Rich, velvety, purple fading to violet, July to September. Green leaves. Height 1.8 to 2.4 metres. Prune hard in Feb. or March.
- C. 'Golden Tiara'** Large yellow upright 'orientalis' type flowers in August and September. Finely cut leaves. Height up to 5 metres. Prune hard in Feb or March.
- C. 'H.F. Young'** Large, mid-blue flowers with a white centre, May, June and again in September. Green leaves. Height 1.8 to 2.4 metres. Prune lightly after the first flowers.
- C. 'Hagley Hybrid'** Shell pink flowers with a contrasting chocolate centre, June to September. Green leaves. Height 1.8 to 2.4 metres. Prune hard in Feb. or March.
- C. 'Henryii'** Very large, creamy white flowers in May and June then smaller flowers in September. Green leaves. Height 1.8 to 2.4 metres. Prune lightly after the first flowers.
- C. 'Huldine'** Pearly white flowers with a mauve bar on the reverse, July to October. Green leaves. Height 1.8 to 2.4 metres. Prune hard in Feb. or March.
- C. 'Harlow Carr'**

- C. 'Jackmanii'** Rich violet purple flowers from July to October. Green leaves. Height 1.8 to 2.4 metres. Prune hard in Feb. or March.
- C. 'Jackmanii Superba'** Large, rich violet purple flowers from July to October. Green leaves. Height 1.8 to 2.4 metres. Prune hard in Feb. or March.
- C. 'Jan Pawel II'** (Pope John Paul II) Whitish flower with a pink tinge and a red centre May, June and September. Mid-green leaves. Height 1.8 to 2.4 m. Prune lightly in July.
- C. 'John Warren'** Pinkish lilac with a deeper bar and margin and a red centre, May, June and again in September. Green leaves. Height 1.8 to 2.4 metres. Prune lightly after the first flowers.
- C. Josephine** Large, fully double, pinkish-mauve flowers from June to September. Mid green leaves. Height 1.8 to 2.4 m. Prune to back to a pair of strong buds in Feb. or March. NO PROPAGATION WITHOUT A LICENSE.
- C. x jouiniana** Small flowers, white tinted lilac, September and October. Mid to dark green, divided leaves. Deciduous. Height will reach 3 metres if given support, not self-twining. Prune hard in February.
- C. 'Kakio'** (Was C. 'Pink Champagne') Mid pink flowers from May to August. Mid green leaves. Height 1.8 to 2.4 m. Prune lightly in July.
- C. 'Lasurstern'** Single, deep blue, flowers with broad tapering, wavy edged sepals. Flowers appear in May, June and then again in September. Mid green leaves. Height 1.8 to 2.4 m. Prune lightly in July.
- C. 'Lincoln Star'** Brilliant raspberry pink with a red centre in early summer. Paler flowers appear in September. Mid green leaves. Height 1.8 to 2.4 m. Prune lightly in July after the first flowers.
- C. macropetala** Bell shaped, lavender blue flowers, in May and June. Occasionally some later. Pale green cut leaves. Height 2.4 metres. Prune only to keep in allotted space.
- C. mac. 'Maidwell Hall'** Bell shaped, fully double, bluish flowers in May and June. Pale green leaflets. Height 2.4 metres. Prune after flowering to keep in allotted space.

C. mac. 'Markham's Pink' Bell shaped mid pink flowers in May and June. Pale green leaflets. Height 2.4 metres. Prune only to keep in allotted space.

C. mac. 'Purple Spider' NEW 1998 Bell shaped, purple flowers with a whitish centre, May and June. Pale green leaflets. Height 2.4 metres. Prune after flowering to keep in allotted space.

C. mac. 'Rosy O' Grady' Bell shaped, light rose-pink, flowers in May and June. Pale green leaflets. Height 2.4 metres. Prune only to keep in allotted space.

C. mac. 'White Swan' Bell shaped white flowers in May and June. Pale green leaflets. Height 2.4 metres. Prune only to keep in allotted space.

C. 'Marie Boisselot' (Was Known as C. 'Mme. Le Coultre') Large white flowers with a cream centre from May to October. Green leaves. Height 1.8 to 2.4 metres. Prune hard in February or March.

C. 'Miss Bateman' White flowers, banded pale green when they first open, appear in May and June. Mid green leaves. Height 1.8 to 2.4 metres. Prune lightly in July.

C. montana f. grandiflora White flowers in May. Dark green divided leaves. Deciduous. Height up to 9 metres. Will grow on most walls and fences. Will tolerate growing on northerly facing walls. Prune lightly after flowering if required.

C. montana 'Elizabeth' Scented, light pink, flowers in May. Dark green divided leaves. Deciduous. Height up to 9 metres. Will tolerate growing on northerly facing walls. Prune lightly after flowering, if required.

C. montana 'Freda' Deep, cherry-pink, flowers with darker edges, May. Dark green divided leaves. Deciduous. Height up to 9 metres. Will tolerate growing on northerly facing walls. Prune lightly after flowering, if required.

C. montana 'Marjorie' Creamy-pink, semi-double, flowers with a salmon pink centre, May. Dark green divided leaves. Deciduous. Height up to 9 metres. Will tolerate growing on northerly facing walls. Prune lightly after flowering, if required.

'Tetrarose' Scented, large, rosy-mauve, flowers in May. Dark green divided leaves. Deciduous. Height up to 9 metres. . Will tolerate growing on northerly facing walls. Prune lightly after flowering, if required.

C. montana var. rubens Scented, rosy-mauve, flowers in May. Dark green divided leaves. Deciduous. Height up to 9 m. Will tolerate growing on northerly facing walls. Prune lightly after flowering, if required.

C. montana var. rubens 'Mayleen' Deep pink flowers with a golden centre, May. Dark green divided leaves. Deciduous. Height up to 9 metres. Will tolerate growing on northerly facing walls. Prune lightly after flowering, if required

C. montana var. rubens 'Pink Perfection' Vanilla scented, deep pink, flowers in May. Dark green divided leaves. Deciduous. Height up to 9 metres. . Will tolerate growing on northerly facing walls. Prune lightly after flowering, if required.

C. montana var. rubens 'Pink Perfection' Vanilla scented, deep pink, flowers in May. Dark green divided leaves. Deciduous. Height up to 9 metres. . Will tolerate growing on northerly facing walls. Prune lightly after flowering, if required.

C. 'Mrs Cholmondely' Large pale blue flowers from May to August. Green leaves. Height 1.8 to 2.4 metres. Prune hard in Feb. or March.

C. 'Mrs N. Thompson' Large violet flowers with a scarlet bar in May, June and September. Mid green leaves. Height 1.8 to 2.4 metres. Prune lightly in July.

C. 'Multiblue' Violet-blue to violet-purple, double flowers. As the flower ages the outer petals fall leaving the central petals. Flowers in May, June, August & September. Prune lightly after first flush of flowers.

C. 'My Angel' Sepals orange-yellow inside, reddish outside, July to September, fluffy seed heads follow. Finely cut leaves. Height 2 to 2.5 metres. Prune hard in Feb. or March.

C. 'Nelly Moser' Pale mauve pink flowers with a central carmine bar. Flowers appear in May, June and again in September. Mid green leaves. Height 1.8 to 2.4 m. Prune lightly in July.

C. 'Niobe' Very deep, velvety red flowers with a greenish yellow centre, June to August. Height 1.8 to 2.4 metres. Prune hard in Feb. or March.

C. 'Perle d' Azur' Light blue flowers from June to September. Green leaves. Height 2.4 to 3 metres. Prune hard in Feb. or March.

C. Petit Faucon 'Evisix'

C. 'Prince Charles' Blue-mauve flowers from June to September. Green leaves. Height 2.4 to 3 metres. Prune hard in Feb. or March.

- C. 'Proteus'** Double, mauve-pink flowers at first, some single flowers later in the season. Flowers appear from June to September. Mid green leaves. Height 1.8 to 2.4 m. Prune lightly in July.
- C. rehderiana** Small, bell shaped, cowslip scented, flowers of pale yellow, August to October. Downy mid-green. Deciduous. Height up to 7 metres. Prune hard in spring.
- C. 'Romantika'** Very dark velvety-red flowers, June to August. Mid-green leaves. Height 1.8 to 2.4 metres. Prune hard in Feb. or March.
- C. 'Rouge Cardinal'** Crimson velvet flowers with a brownish centre, May, June and September. Mid-green leaves. Height 1.8 to 2.4 m.. Prune lightly in July.
- C. 'Royalty'** Double, rosette shaped, purple flowers from June to September. Mid green leaves. Height 1.8 to 2.4 m. Prune lightly in July if necessary.
- C. 'Star of India'** Deep purple flowers with a carmine stripe, July and August. Height 2 to 3 metres. Prune hard in Feb. or March.
- C. tangutica** Lantern-shaped, single yellow flowers 4cm long, from August to October and followed by attractive seed heads. Finely divided mid green leaves. Height 4 to 5 metres. Prune hard in spring.
- C. terniflora (Was C. maximowicziana)** White, hawthorn scented, flowers in September and October. Flowers best after hot summers. Waxy green leaves. Deciduous. Height can reach 9 metres.
- C. texensis 'Duchess of Albany'** Pink bell shaped flowers from July to September. Slender green leaves. Height to 1.8 to 3 metres. Prune hard in Feb. or March.
- C. texensis 'Etoile Rose'** Nodding, bell shaped flowers, deep cherry pink with pink edges, July to September. Slender green leaves. Height to 1.8 metres. Prune hard in Feb. or March.
- C. texensis 'Gravetye Beauty'** Nodding, bell shaped flowers, cherry red fading to pink, July to September. Slender green leaves. Height to 1.8 metres. Prune hard in Feb. or March.
- C. texensis 'Princess Diana'** Nodding, bell shaped, red flowers, July to September. Slender green leaves. Height to 3 to 4 metres. Prune hard in Feb. or March.
- C. texensis 'Sir Trevor Lawrence'** Bell shaped flowers, striped red and pink. July to September. Slender green leaves. Height to 1.8 metres. Prune hard in Feb. or March.
- C. 'The President'** Deep purple-blue flowers silvery on the reverse, June to September. Mid green leaves. Height 2.4 to 3.6 metres. Prune lightly in after flowering, can be hard pruned.
- C. tibetana** Lime green, thick-sepalled flowers with darker stamens, August and September. Finely cut leaves. Height up to 5 m. Prune hard in Feb. or March.
- C. tib. vernayi 'Orange Peel (Was C. orientalis 'Orange Peel')** Yellowish, bell shaped, thick sepalled flowers in August and September. Finely cut leaves. Height up to 5 metres. Prune hard Feb. or March.
- C. x triternata 'Rubromarginata'** Masses of small, purple, white, centred scented flowers from August to October. Dark green, divided leaves. Deciduous. Height 3.5 metres. Prune hard in February.
- C. 'Ville de Lyon'** Single, bright carmine red flowers 8-10 cm across, with darker petal edges and yellow anthers appearing from July to September. Mid green leaves. Prune hard in February.
- C. viticella 'Abundance'** Purple-red flowers with darker veins and a creamy centre, June to September. Slender green leaves. Height 2.7 metres. Prune hard in Feb. or March.
- C. viticella 'Alba Luxurians'** White flowers, often with green tips, with dark anthers, from June to September. Slender mid green leaves. Height 2.5 to 3 metres. Deciduous. Prune hard in February.
- C. viticella 'Etoile Violette'** Deep purple flowers with a creamy centre, June to September. Slender green leaves. Height 2.7 metres. Prune hard in Feb. or March.
- C. viticella 'Kermesina'** Deep, velvety crimson flowers, with a very dark centre, June to September. Slender green leaves. Height 2.7 metres. Prune hard in Feb. or March.
- C. viticella 'Little Nell'** Broad outer band of pale mauve with a white central bar, greenish centre. July to September. Slender green leaves. Height 2.7 metres. Prune hard in Feb. or March.
- C. viticella 'Madame Julia Correvon'** Clear rosy-red flowers from July to September. Slender green leaves. Height 4.5 metres. Prune hard in Feb. or March.
- C. viticella 'Margot Koster'** Rosy-pink flowers from July to October Slender green leaves. Height 4 metres. Prune hard in Feb. or March.
- C. viticella 'Mignet'** Creamy-white flowers with mauve veins and margined deep mauve, June to September. Slender green leaves. Height 2.7 metres. Prune hard in Feb. or March.
- C. viticella 'Polish Spirit'** Purplish flowers from July to September. Slender green leaves. Height 4.5 metres. Prune hard in Feb. or March.

- C. viticella 'Purpurea Plena Elegans'** Small, double, flowers of soft rose purple, June to September. Slender green leaves. Height 2.7 metres. Prune hard in Feb. or March.
- C. viticella 'Royal Velours'** Dark rich purple, velvety flowers, June to September. Largest flowers in this group. Slender green leaves. Height 2.7 metres. Prune hard in Feb. or March.
- C. viticella 'Venosa Violacea'** Large, white flowers, shaded to purple at the edges, June to September. Slender green leaves. Height 2.7 metres. Prune hard in Feb. or March.
- C. 'Voluteau'** Large, reddish-purple, flowers with a cream centre, June to September. Green leaves. Height 1.8 to 2.4 metres. Prune hard in Feb. or March.
- C. 'Vyvyan Pennell'** Large, fully double, violet blue flowers at first, some single flowers later in the season. Flowers appear from May to July. Mid green leaves. Height 1.8 to 2.4 m. Prune lightly in July.
- C. 'Wada' s Primrose'** Pale creamy white flowers appear in May, June and September. Mid green leaves. Height 1.5 metres. Prune lightly in July.
- C. 'Warszawska Nike'** Flowers are violet with golden stamens, flowering from May to September. Height 1.8 to 2.4 metres. Prune hard in Feb. or March.
- C. 'W.E. Gladstone'** Very large, silky lavender flowers with a purple centre, June to September. Green leaves. Height 1.8 to 2.4 metres. Prune hard in Feb. or March.
- C. Wisley**

COBAEA *Annual climber. Requires a well-drained sunny site.*

C. scandens Green and purple bell shaped flowers, July – October. Height up to 3 metres in a warm summer.

DREGEA *Deciduous twining climber.*

D. sinensis (Was **Wattakaka sinensis**) Scented, white, waxy flowers with a central cone of red spots, June to August. Heart shaped green leaves often splashed and mottled white. Height to 2.4 metres.

FALLOPIA *A rampant, twining climber. Will grow in most soils in sun or part shade.*

F. baldschuanicum (Was **Polygonum baldschanicum**) Clusters of white or greenish-white flowers turning pinkish in fruit, July to September. Heart shaped, bright green leaves. Deciduous. Height to 9 m.

HEDERA (*Ivy*) *Evergreen, woody-stemmed, self-clinging climber. Will grow in most soils in sun or shade. HARMFUL IF EATEN. MAY CAUSE SKIN ALLERGY.*

H. canariensis 'Gloire de Marengo' Large deep green centred leaves, merging into silvery-grey and margined white. Height and Spread: 2.4 to 4.5 metres.

H. colchica Large, oval, unlobed dark green leaves. Height and Spread: to 6 metres or more. May be used as groundcover. Will grow even in quite dark shade.

H. colchica 'Dentata Variegata' Large bright green leaves, shaded grey, conspicuously marked creamy yellow when young turning creamy white with age. Ht and Spread: 2.4 to 4.5 metres.

H. colchica 'Sulphur Heart' (Was H. c. 'Paddy' s Pride') large dark green leaves, splashed in the centre with yellow which turns pale then dark green. Height and Spread: 2.4 to 4.5 metres.

H. helix 'Buttercup' Rich yellow young leaves becoming yellowish green or pale green as the season progresses. Height slow growing to 1.5 metres.

H. helix 'Caecilia' (Was H.h. 'Clotted Cream') Pale and mid green leaves edged cream, some leaves entirely cream. Height to 3 metres.

H. helix 'Glacier' Silvery-grey leaves with a narrow white margin. Height to 3 metres.

H. helix 'Goldchild' Young leaves, bright green, pale yellow in the centre and with a broad golden yellow margin. Then become blue-green and grey-green margined yellow. Height to 3 metres. Moist soil.

H. helix 'Green Ripple' Dark green, shiny, leaves with a jagged edge and a long central point Height often up to 3 metres. Can be used as a climber or as groundcover. Will grow even in quite dark shade.

H. helix 'Oro di Bogliasco' (Was **H. helix 'Goldheart'**) Dark green leaves with bright yellow centres. Height 6 metres.

H. helix 'Midas Touch' Dark green leaves heavily splashed yellow, lobed rather than pointed edges. Height to 3 metres.

H. helix 'Parsley Crested' Green crinkly edged margin, often pink tinged in winter. Height often up to 3 metres. Can be used as a climber or as groundcover.

H. helix 'Sagittifolia' Dark green, arrow shaped, leaves. Height often up to 3 metres. Can be used as a climber or as groundcover.

H. helix 'Tricolor' (Was H.h. ' **Marginata Elegantissima'**) Small leaves of greyish-green, margined white and edged pink in the winter. Height to 3 metres.

H. hibernica Large, dark green, usually five pointed leaves. Height and Spread: to 6 metres or more. May be used as groundcover.

HOLBOELLIA *A twining climber. Needs full sun and a sheltered wall.*

H. coriacea Purplish male flowers, greenish-white, tinged purple female flowers. Purple, sausage-shaped pods follow. Evergreen leaves made up of several leaflets. Height to about 5.5 metres.

H. latifolia Fragrant flowers in March, the male flowers are greenish-white, the female flowers purplish. Purple, sausage-shaped pods follow. Evergreen leaves made up of 3 to 7 leaflets.

HUMULUS (*Hop*) *Herbaceous, twining climber. Requires full sun and well-drained soil.*

H. lupulus 'Aureus' Rough, hairy stems and toothed yellow leaves divided into 3 or 5 lobes, greenish yellow later. Greenish, female flower spikes are borne in pendent clusters in autumn. Height 6 metres.

HYDRANGEA *A self-clinging climber. Good for shady places or north walls.*

H. anomala ssp.petiolaris Large, lacy, heads of greenish white fertile flowers with sterile florets around the edge, June. Broad dark green, shiny, leaves. Deciduous. Height can reach 12 metres. May be pruned after flowering.

H. seemannii Heads of white flowers. Leathery green leaves, evergreen. Height can reach 12 metres May be pruned after flowering. Best in a sheltered site

JASMINUM *Woody stemmed, twining climber. Grown for its fragrant flowers. Requires full sun and well-drained soil. Some varieties are tender and must be kept frost free.*

J. officinale Clusters of fragrant, white flowers are borne from June to September. Green three or five lobed leaves. Deciduous. Height to 4.5 metres. Prune after flowering if required.

J. officinale 'Argenteovariegatum' Clusters of fragrant, white flowers are borne from June to September. Grey-green three or five lobed leaves, margined creamy-white. Deciduous. Height to 4.5 metres. Prune after flowering if required.

J. officinale 'Aureum' Clusters of fragrant, white flowers are borne from June to September. Green three or five lobed leaves, marked with yellow. Deciduous. Height to 4.5 m. Prune after flowering if required.

J. officinale 'Fiona Sunrise' Clusters of fragrant, white flowers are borne from June to September. Golden yellow leaves from Spring to Autumn, deciduous. Height to 4.5 metres. **NO UNAUTHORISED PROPAGATION OF THIS PLANT.**

J. officinale 'Inverleith' Clusters of red buds open to white scented flowers are borne from June to September. Reddish green three or five lobed leaves. Deciduous. Height to 4.5 metres. Prune after flowering if required.

J. polyanthum Intensely fragrant white flowers flushed rose on the outside May to December under glass. climber to 4.5 metres. Prune after flowering if required. **CONSERVATORY PLANT.**

J. x stephanense Fragrant, pale pink flowers in June and July. Narrow divided green leaves, flushed creamy yellow. Height to 4.5 to 6 metres. Full sun in a fertile soil, can be pruned after flowering if required.

LONICERA (*Honeysuckle*) *A vigorous twining climber. Different varieties require different conditions.*

L. x americana (Also known as **L. x italica**) Clusters of white, soon becoming pale, then dark yellow with a purple tinge outside, June and July. Grey green leaves. Deciduous. Height to 6 metres. Sun or part shade in a moist well-drained soil.

L. x brownii 'Dropmore Scarlet' Tubular, bright scarlet flowers from July to October. Mid green leaves. Deciduous. Height to 4.5 metres. Most soils in sun or part shade.

L. caprifolium (Also known as L. cap. 'Early Cream') Creamy white flowers in June and July followed by orange-red berries. Greyish green leaves. Deciduous. Height to about 6 metres. Well-drained, moist soil in sun or part shade.

L. x heckrotti 'Goldflame' Scented, yellow flowers, flushed purple held on the ends of the shoots, July to August. Greyish green leaves. Deciduous. Height a twining shrubby climber to about 4.5 metres. Will tolerate a wide range of soils.

L. henryii Small, yellow flowers stained red, June and July and followed by black berries. Glossy green leaves, paler below, evergreen or semi-evergreen. Height to about 6 metres. Most soils and aspects.

L. x italica Harlequin 'Sherlite' Reddish purple outside, creamy white inside, sweetly fragrant, May, June and often again in late summer. Leaves variegated green, cream and pink. Deciduous. Height to 6 metres. Sun or part shade in a well-drained soil.

L. japonica 'Aureoreticulata' Bright green, attractively marbled yellow, leaves, especially in the spring. Deciduous. Rarely flowers. Height to 3 metres. Sun and a well-drained soil.

L. japonica 'Halliana' Very fragrant, white flowers aging to pale yellow are borne from June to October. Pale green leaves evergreen except in exposed sites and hard weather. Height to about 6 metres. Will grow in sun or shade in most soils.

L. japonica var. repens Very fragrant, white flowers, flushed purple on the outside from June to September. Dark green leaves and stems flushed purple. Deciduous. Height to 6 metres. Well-drained, moist soil.

L. 'Mandarin' Tubular, bright orange scarlet flowers from July to October. Mid green leaves. Deciduous. Height to 4.5 metres. Most soils in sun or part shade. sun or part shade.

L. periclymenum 'Belgica' Reddish purple outside, creamy white inside, sweetly fragrant, May, June and often again in late summer. Dark green leaves, greyish below. Deciduous. Height to 6 metres. Sun or part shade in a well-drained soil.

L. periclymenum. 'Graham Thomas' White bud open to fragrant, white, flowers which gradually age to yellow, June to September. Dark green leaves, greyish below. Deciduous. Height to 6 metres. Sun or part shade in a well-drained soil.

L. periclymenum 'Serotina' Reddish purple outside, creamy white inside, sweetly fragrant, July to October. Dark green leaves, greyish below. Deciduous. Height to 6 metres. Sun or part shade in a well-drained soil.

L. x tellmanniana Bright yellowish-orange flowers are carried in clusters at the ends of the shoots in June and July. Oval green leaves. Deciduous. Height to 4.5 metres. Best in partial or even full shade and well-drained soil.

L. tragophylla Bright, golden-yellow, tubular flowers in clusters on the ends of the shoots, June and July. Dark green leaves, greyish beneath. Deciduous. Height to 6 metres. Best grown in almost complete shade, useful for growing through trees.

MITRARIA *Evergreen. Woody-stemmed, scrambling climber. Requires partial shade and well-drained acidic soil. Grown in our evergreen shrub section.*

M. coccinea Small, tubular, orange-red flowers from late June to September. Glossy green leaves. Height low growing 0.3 metres. Spread 0.3 to 0.6 metres.

PARTHENOCISSUS (*Virginia Creeper*) *Self-clinging climber grown for its autumn colour. Sun or part shade in a moist, well-drained soil.*

P. henryana Leaves have 3-5 oval toothed leaflets that are velvety, deep green or bronze with white or pinkish veins. Very good autumn colour. Small dark blue berries appear in autumn. Height climbs by twining tendrils to about 6 metres.

P. quinquefolia Leaves have 5 oval toothed, dull green leaflets paler beneath, that turn crimson in autumn. Deciduous. Blue-black berries appear in autumn, after hot summers. Height to 6 m., often more.

P. quinquefolia var. engelmannii Leaves have 5 oval toothed, dull green leaflets paler beneath, that turn crimson in autumn. Blue-black berries may appear in autumn. Height 6 metres or more.

P. tricuspidata Variable, lobed and toothed green leaves turning to spectacular, crimson, autumn leaf colour. Dark blue berries may appear in autumn. Height will cover large expanses of wall, may reach 15 metres.

P. tricuspidata 'Lowii' Small, crinkly, palmate 5 to 7 lobed leaves, rich crimson, autumn leaf colour. Dark blue berries may appear in autumn. Height will cover large expanses of wall, may reach 15 metres.
P. tricuspidata 'Minutifolia' VERY UNUSUAL FORM Small variable green leaves turning to spectacular, crimson, autumn leaf colour. Dark blue berries may appear in autumn. Height to 3 or 4 metres.
P. tricuspidata 'Veitchii' Medium sized, ovate or trifoliate leaves, purple when young, rich crimson, autumn leaf colour. Dark blue berries may appear in autumn. Height will cover large expanses of wall, may reach 15 metres.

PASSIFLORA (*Passion Flower*) Evergreen or semi-evergreen climber. Climbs by using tendrils. Requires full sun, a sheltered site and well-drained soil.

P. caerulea White flowers, with blue, white and purple filaments in the centre, from July until the first frosts. Dark green leaves made up of several leaflets, semi-evergreen. Height to 8 metres.

P. caerulea 'Constance Elliott' Pure white flowers, with white filaments in the centre, from July until the first frosts. Dark green leaves made up of several leaflets, semi-evergreen. Height to 8 metres.

PILEOSTEGIA. *Slow growing evergreen climber. Requires sun or shade in a fertile soil.*

P. virburnoides Large heads of tiny, white or cream flowers, with many prominent stamens are borne in heads from August to October. Large, leathery, dark green leaves. Height climbs, slowly, using aerial roots to 6 metres.

PLUMBAGO *Fast-growing, evergreen, woody-stemmed, scrambling climber. Minimum temperature 7 degrees C. Requires full sun and well-drained soil.*

P. auriculata Trusses of sky blue flowers are carried from early summer to winter. Height 3-6m.

P. auriculata var. alba Trusses of white flowers are carried from early summer to winter. Height 3-6m.

RHODOCHITON *Evergreen, leafy stalked climber, usually grown as an annual. Rich well-drained, moist soil in full sun. Not hardy.*

R. atrosanguineus Curious flowers with blackish-purple calyx, and bell-shaped, red-purple corolla, appear all summer. Toothed leaves. Height to 3 metres.

SCHISANDRA *A deciduous, twining climber. Requires sun or partial shade and a well-drained, moist, soil.*

S. rubriflora Crimson flowers in clusters during May. Leathery, dark green leaves. Height to 6 metres.

SCHIZOPHRAGMA *A deciduous self-clinging climber. Requires full sun and well-drained soil. Can be damaged by snails.*

S. hydrangeoides White flowers are borne in flat heads up to 25cm across, marginal sterile flowers, each having a large, white bract, July. Height 12 metres.

S. hydrangeoides 'Moonlight' Large flower heads of creamy-white flowers in July. Unusual silvery-green leaves. Height 12 metres.

S. hydrangeoides 'Roseum' Blush pink flowers are borne in flat heads up to 25cm across, marginal sterile flowers, each having a large, white bract, July. Height to 12 metres.

S. integrifolium White flowers are borne in flat heads up to 30cm across, marginal sterile flowers, each having a large, white bract, July. Height to 12 metres.

SOLANUM Vigorous, evergreen, or semi evergreen, woody stemmed, scrambling climber. Requires full sun and well-drained soil.

S. crispum Clusters of lilac to purple flowers in summer. Oval leaves Height to 6 metres.

S. crispum 'Glasnevin' Rich purple-blue flowers with a yellow staminal beak, from July to the first frosts. Bright green leaves, semi-evergreen. Height up to 6 metres in sheltered sites. Best on south or west facing sites.

S. laxum (Was jasminoides) Has star shaped, slate-blue, flowers, 2 to 2.5cm across, each with a yellow 'beak' sticking out, June to October. bright green leaves, semi-evergreen. Height 6 to 9 metres.

S. laxum 'Album' (Was jasminoides 'Album') Has star shaped, white flowers, 2 to 2.5cm across, each with a yellow 'beak' sticking out, June to October. bright green leaves, semi-evergreen. Height 6 to 9 metres.

S. laxum 'Aureo-variegatum' (Was S. jasminoides 'Aureo-variegatum') Star shaped, white flowers, 2 to 2.5cm across, each with a yellow 'beak' sticking out, June to October. Bright green, with yellow variegation, semi-evergreen. Height 6 to 9 metres.

SOLLYA *Evergreen, twining climber. Requires full sun and well-drained soil and is best as a conservatory plant.*

S. heterophylla Nodding clusters of bell-shaped, sky-blue flowers from June to September. Narrow bright green leaves. Height to 3 metres.

S. heterophylla 'Alba' Nodding clusters of bell-shaped, white flowers from June to September. Narrow bright green leaves. Height to 3 metres.

S. heterophylla 'Pink Charmer' Nodding clusters of bell-shaped, pink flowers from June to September. Narrow bright green leaves. Height to 3 metres.

STAUNTONIA *An evergreen twining climber. Best on a sheltered wall in sun or part shade.*

S. hexaphylla White, tinged violet, flowers in April and May. Egg shaped fruits may follow but only after a warm summer. Dark green leaves. Height to 7 metres.

TRACHELOSPERMUM *A slow growing evergreen twining climber. Needs a warm sunny sheltered wall.*

T. asiaticum Fragrant creamy white flowers with a buff yellow centre, July and August. Mid green leaves. Height and Spread: to about 5 metres.

T. jasminoides Very fragrant white flowers are carried in July and August. Dark, shiny, green leaves. Height to 6 metres.

T. jasminoides 'Variegatum' Very fragrant white flowers in July and August. Grey green leaves splashed and margined creamy white, often suffused crimson in the winter. Height and Spread: to 7 metres.

T. jasminoides 'Wilsonii' Very fragrant white flowers in July and August, becoming cream with age. Shiny dark green leaves with attractive veining, crimson in winter. Height to about 5 metres.

TROPAEOLUM *Herbaceous, twining climber. Requires full sun and well-drained soil.*

T. speciosum Bears scarlet flowers in summer followed by indigo fruits. Lobed, rich green leaves. Height 3 metres or more. Best against a north facing wall or hedge. The roots need to be shaded from the sun.

T. tuberosum Greyish green leaves have 3-5 lobes; from mid summer to late autumn, has cup shaped flowers with orange-yellow petals, orange-red sepals and a long spur. Height 2 to 3 metres.

TWEEDIA *A twining climber for the conservatory.*

T. caerulea (Was Oxypetalum caeruleum) Powder blue flowers turn purplish then lilac and are followed by pods that open to reveal silvery seeds, summer flowering. Sage green, heart shaped to oblong, leaves. Deciduous.

VITIS (Vine) *A deciduous climber which climbs using tendrils. Requires well-drained soil in a sunny position.*

V. 'Black Hamburgh' (Also known as V. 'Schiava Grossa') Greenish flowers, then grapes of dark blue-black with a white bloom when ripe. Deeply cut, green, leaves turn dark red to purple with distinct veins. Height can grow over 10 metres but can be pruned.

V. 'Brant' Small greenish flowers followed by sweet, aromatic, grapes of dark blue-black with a white bloom when ripe. Deeply cut, green, leaves turn dark red to purple with distinct veins. Height can grow over 10 metres but can be pruned.

V. cognetiae Small, greenish, flowers followed by black fruits with a purple bloom. Broad, rounded, green leaves turn crimson and scarlet in the autumn. Height to 10 metres.

V. cognetiae 'Claret Cloak' Small, greenish, flowers followed by black fruits with a purple bloom. Broad, rounded, coppery purple, young, leaves turn green then crimson and scarlet in the autumn. Height to 10 metres.

V. 'Fragola' (Was known as V. ' Strawberry Grape) Small greenish flowers followed by red grapes said to have a flavour reminiscent of strawberries. Deeply cut, green, leaves. Height can grow over 10 metres but can be pruned.

V. 'Madeleine Silvaner' Small greenish flowers followed by white grapes. Deeply cut, green, leaves. Height can grow over 10 metres but can be pruned.

V. 'Muller-Thurgau' Small greenish flowers followed by golden-brown grapes. Deeply cut, green, leaves. Height can grow over 10 metres but can be pruned.

V. vinifera 'Chardonnay' Small greenish flowers followed by white grapes. Deeply cut, green, leaves. Height can grow over 10 metres but can be pruned. Best in the sun. An outdoor grape.

V. vinifera 'Purpurea' Greenish flowers, then grapes of blue-black. Deeply cut leaves turn red then purple. Height can grow over 6 metres but can be pruned.

WISTERIA *A deciduous, twining climber. Needs a sunny wall. Will grow in most soils. Prune to keep within bounds in winter, shorten new growth in August.*

W. brachybotris 'Shiro-kabitan' (Was W. venusta) White, large and slightly fragrant flowers in short trusses May and June. Green leaves. Height 3 metres or more.

W. 'Caroline' Soft lavender mauve flowers in in May and June, a few later. Mid green leaves. Height 10 metres or more.

W. floribunda 'Alba' White flowers, lilac on the keel, May, June a few later. Pale green leaves made up of many leaflets. Height 3 metres or more.

W. floribunda 'Domino'

W. floribunda 'Multijuga' Fragrant, lilac, tinged blue-purple flowers, May, June and a few later. Pale green leaves made up of leaflets. Height 3 metres or more.

W. floribunda 'Rosea' Pale rose -coloured flowers tipped purple in May and June, a few later. Pale green leaves made up of many leaflets. Height 3 metres or more.

W. floribunda 'Snow Showers' White flowers in May and June, sometimes a few later. Pale green leaves made up of many small leaflets. Height 3 metres or more.

W. x formosa 'Black Dragon' (Also known as W. 'Yae-kokuryu') 30cm dark purple, double, flowers May and June. Mid green leaves. Height 4 metres or more.

W. sinensis Mauve to deep lilac, 30cm long, fragrant, May and June a few later. Mid green leaves. Height 10 metres or more.

W. sinensis 'Alba' White in trusses about 30cm long, fragrant, May and June a few later. Mid green leaves. Deciduous. Height 10 m. or more. Will grow on a sunny wall or through a large tree in most soils.

W. sinensis 'Prolific' Mauve to lilac trusses, even on young plants, May and June a few later.. Mid green leaves. Deciduous. Height 10 m. or more. Will grow on a sunny wall or through a large tree in most soils.
